Wine	: “Un Buon Momento...” Moscato d’Asti , ‘A good time...’
Appellation	: Santo Stefano Belbo
Grape varietal	: 100% Moscato Bianco
Age of vines	: Between 30-40 year old vines
Soil	: Light gray marl and sandstone, marine sedimentation
Harvest	: Hand-harvested in late August or first week of September
Yield per plant	: 3 Kg
Vinification	: Fermented in refrigerated steel for conservation of must
Aging	: 36 months total; 24 months in Slovenian oak, rest in bottle
Color	: Straw yellow with very fine carbonation
Nose	: Intense but delicate with hints of flowers and fruits
Taste	: Elegant and refined with delicate sweetness and long fruited finish
Alcohol	: 5.5%
Bottle	: Albeisa
Stopper	: Natural cork
Size	: 12/750ml



A little taste of Asti in every sip- flowers of sage, orange, acacia, lime and Mediterranean fruit. Balanced, with a refreshing acidity and minerality that persists through the finish, this moscato delights all drinkers. Easy to pair with dry pastries, dessert, or fresh fruit. A harmonious lightly sparkling and refreshing wine.
